

Getting Here:

Located conveniently at the heart of the United Kingdom, the Yorkshire Dales is very accessible:

By Road

Via the M6:

Travelling from the **North**; exit the M6 at junction 36, and follow the signs to Kirkby Lonsdale (A65).

Travelling from the **South**, exit the M6 at junction 21A, and follow the signs to Leeds, Bolton, Manchester (M62) and then the M60.

Via the A1(M):

Travelling from the **North**; exit the A1(M) at junction 47 and follow signs for Harrogate and Skipton (A59), and then the A65.

Travelling from the **South**; exit the A1(M) at junction 47 and follow signs for Harrogate and Skipton (A59), and then the A65.

By Rail

Frequent, direct trains carry visitors from London to Leeds in just over two hours. There are also regular services to Leeds from Scotland, the Northeast, the Midlands and the Northwest.
